On **Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June** we are honoured to receive a first-class relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis for Veneration. He is a teenage saint of our own age who had a great devotion to the Eucharist, as well as using the Internet to share the wonders of Eucharistic Miracles all over the world. His words of wisdom are profound – “The Eucharist is my Highway to Heaven” – “People who place themselves before the sun get a tan, while people who place themselves before the Eucharist become Saints”.

There will be a brief nugget about Bl Carlo shared at the end of the 11.30am Mass, with the opportunity to venerate the relic immediately after the Mass.

You are also warmly invited to a longer gathering with Jacqui in St Dunstan's Church, beginning at **4pm on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June**, where she'll be diving into **the life and legacy of Bl Carlo**, concluding with a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until the beginning of the 5.30pm Mass. Another opportunity to venerate the relic follows the evening Mass.
