

Next weekend is the annual collection for the Johnson Association (now called The Johnson Clergy Association (Bham) CIO). During the past year, they have assisted over 65 priests of the Diocese who are either retired or who have been off sick from the parish. Grants of over £375,000 have been awarded to the retired and sick clergy of the diocese. At present, there are 60 priests aged over 75 who are assisted and supported by the Association and there are approximately 13 priests over 75 who are still working within the parish setting full time. Your donations in the Parish collection help support this work.
