ETIQUETTE FOR CHURCH

Whilst it is wonderful for us to welcome so many families to Sunday Mass, it is important for us all to be respectful in God's house.

Over the last few months, parishioners have shared their concerns with me. Please could I remind you of the following:

- Silence should be maintained before, during, and after Mass to allow people to pray. You are more than welcome to talk outside of the main body of the church.
- Parents must take responsibility for their children at all times.
- Parishioners must never be on the sanctuary space outside Mass, unless for cleaning or decorating. Children are permitted only when serving Mass.
- Respect must be shown to church property and gardens at all times. The life size crucifix in St Jude's garden must be shown the utmost reverence. Children climbing on it is absolutely forbidden.
- Consideration should be shown to those who give up their time to stewarding so that they can lock up the church in a timely manner.

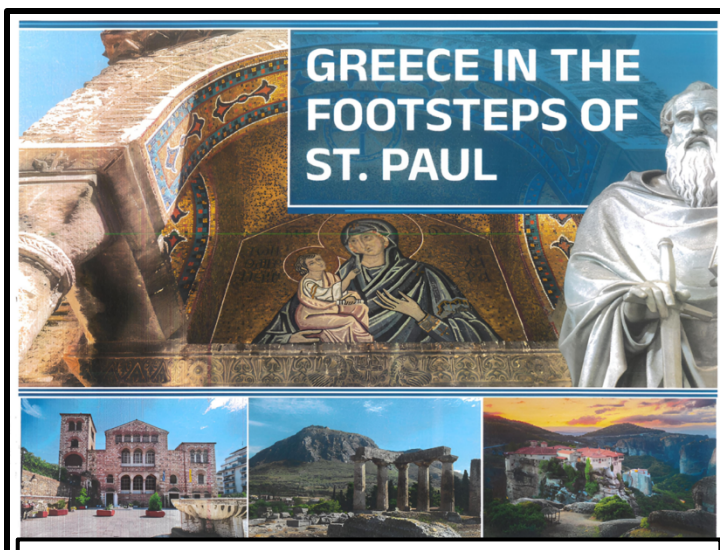
