During this "Green" Liturgical Season the seeds sown during the great feasts of the Liturgical Year are given time and space to spring up and flourish as do our gardens. This week, we welcome Fr Saviour Grima and a team of seven members of the Legion of Mary from Malta. They will be working in St Jude's Parish and visiting home-to-home. They will be trying to share their Catholic faith with all whom they will meet. They come at their own expense to do this work. I am grateful for the parishioners who are offering them accommodation and/or helping with the catering arrangements. Please keep them and their work of evangelisation in your prayers.
