It is fitting that this Sunday, we celebrate Catholic Communications Day. Next Saturday, there will be children receiving their first Holy Communion at the 12.30pm and 4pm Masses. Please keep them and their families in your prayers.

On Saturdays 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> June when there are First Holy Communion Masses at St Dunstan's, there will be no adoration following the 11am Mass but there will still be confessions from 11.30am to 12.15pm.
