LENT

Lent is a season of reflection and preparation that marks the 40 days leading up to Easter Sunday. For Catholics, Lent is an important time of year, as it provides an opportunity to deepen our relationship with God and to prepare our hearts for the celebration of Christ's resurrection. During Lent, we are called to engage in prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, and these are some of the things in our Parish you can participate in:

- Stations of the Cross (Tuesdays after Mass at St Jude's, and Fridays at 6.15pm at St Dunstan's), as well as frequent celebrations of Mass.
- **Early Bird Mass** on Thursday mornings at 6.45am with tea/coffee and toast available in the Conference Room afterwards once again.
- Mondays at 7.30pm, evening Mass at St Jude's.
- Lenten Soup Lunches on Thursdays after morning Mass. The soup lunches will be raising money for CAFOD. Come and join us for a simple lunch. We pray that we may allow our hearts to be touched at Lend by the cry of our sisters and brothers living in poverty. Amen.
- Confession. The Holy Week Penitential Service is at St Dunstan's on Monday 14th April at 7.30pm.

For personal devotion, you might like to take the Walk With Me booklet available at the back of church. Also, we are so fortunate that St Dunstan's church is open each day for private prayer and visits to the Blessed Sacrament. Do make good use of these open doors, especially during this season of Lent.

Parish Lenten Alms Project. The money that you are saving through your various Lenten practices can be given in at a collection at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday night. Fr John is proposing that this money will go to the Parish of Fr Herman Kihuha in Murang'a Diocese, Kenya. He spent some time with Fr Herman last summer. His parish has many needs.
